Special Section of Papers Selected from 1999 International Technical Conference on Circuits/Systems, Computers and Communications (ITC-CSCC'99)

Started in 1986, featuring a relatively small number of papers authored by researchers of circuits and systems area of those days, ITC-CSCC has grown into a large annual international conference reflecting the diversity of the circuits, systems, computers and communications area. 1999 International Technical Conference on Circuits/Systems, Computers and Communications (ITC-CSCC'99) was held successfully in Sado Island, Niigata, Japan, July 13-15, 1999, in which the theme was "Flap of Wing to 21st Century Global Network." The paper presented were 354 in total: 335 papers in regular sessions, 15 papers in special sessions and 4 papers in invited talks at the conference.
