### 「課外活動スケジュール表」 (Extracurricular Schedule)

1. これは、私の最後の期の「課外活動スケジュール表」計10号分である。私の為の留学生会主催の送別会がその中にある。留学生センターは6ヶ月を周期に動いているので、この表も、4月と10月に1号が出る。それぞれ、大体10号位が発行された。

2. このスケジュールに関しては、本文中にも何回か触れているが、そのままを残すことが参考になり易いと考えて、附録とすることにした。やり方は、次のようであった。

- 1) 每期、表紙の絵を変えて、グループ毎のIDとなるようにした。
- 2) 発行の時期は、必要を感じ、可能な時とした。なかなか時間が取れないので、いつもぎりぎりで作っていた。
- 3) 内容は、自分で集めた情報(新潟日報、市報にいがた、りゅうとぴあ情報、各市民団体など)に、留学生センターの計画する諸企画、自主企画を加えたものが中心となった。
- 4) 分かり易いように、日付順にしてある。その中には、申し込み締切日もできるだけ入れて、注意を喚起した。その際、可能な人数など、判断の為の材料も入れるようにした。
- 5) 何時から何処で、何かがある、という点を強調。何かがあるかの説明も出来るだけ簡略にした。留学生センターはISC、国際交流会館はI-HOUSE、留学生会はISAN、国際ヴォランティアサークルはIVC、など馴染みを作るように意識した。FCFSはFirst Come First Served, 先着順。留学生センター行事は大体この原則。
- 6) 余白は、出来る限り有効に使うように考慮した。詩や、西スポーツセンターの予定、年度末のヴィザ関係の注意などはその例である。
- 7) 情報があると、とりあえずファイルしておき、まとまった段階で、それを編集した。留学生課との連絡は特に重要である。それぞれの行事に関して、確認事項がいろいろ出てくる。何時も、自分が留学生だったらどんなことを知りたいかと考えた。
- 8) 発行の都度古い部分を削除し、新しい情報を付け加えるので、中間の部分は何号かに互って通知されることになる。
- 9) 留学生が知っておいた方が良くと思われる学内外の情報の7割をカバーできたかなと自負している。5年間の発行で、留学生がここに情報があるという認識が相当出来てきた。

3. 印刷は毎回色のついた用紙に約70部位。教員、留学生課全員に即配布。主として留学生センター内に分かるように工夫して置いた。同時に、留学生センターのホームページに掲載した。
